

Ethics and Social Responsibility in Tourism Programme Call for Interest for Trainees Terms of Reference

UNWTO (located in Madrid) is looking for an intern to collaborate in the areas of work related to the promotion of the Global Code of Ethics for Tourism. Within this framework, the selected candidate will be assisting in the following fields of action, depending on his/her academic background and previous professional experience, if applicable:

a) Private Sector Commitment to the Global Code of Ethics for Tourism;

b) Child Protection in Tourism;

c) Accessible Tourism for All;

d) Providing support to the Programme with international events (incl. administrative support, registration and other logistics, etc.);

e) Updating of webpage & database, drafting of official correspondence, reports and minutes

f) Any other activity related to the areas of work of the Programme, if requested

The candidates should meet the following requirements:

a) Under-graduate or post-graduate studies in the field of social sciences, international relations, international law, tourism, or related training and work experience;

b) Excellent command of both written and oral English; experience in drafting documents, research papers, articles and correspondence in English is an asset;

c) Interest in human rights, ethics, social policies, responsible tourism and the UN system;

d) Ability to work in international environment and adapt quickly to different working cultures.

The preferred period of internship would be from January to June 2016.
